Holy Trinity Breakfast Club was set up to provide parents with good quality child-care in a safe environment which gives you the opportunity to pursue work and other commitments.

Our Club is run by trained, qualified staff who will provide children with a healthy breakfast and activities to enable children to have an enjoyable and fun start to the day.

We accommodate children aged 5 to 11 years.

Breakfast includes: choice of cereal, toast with jams and honey, and a selection of fruit. Drinks available are fruit juice, squash, water and milk.

Activities will include games, arts and craft, and loads more! There will also be a quiet area available for reading or to rest.

We run the club according to the same values and ethos of the school.

Our Club actively welcomes children from all backgrounds regardless of social, economic background, ethnicity, culture or religion in accordance with our admissions policy.

We offer a fully inclusive club that complies with the Disability Discrimination Act.

Please note that to ensure the children's safety:

Children are signed in and signed out, and will only be permitted to leave with an authorised person.

Staff are qualified, experienced and trained to encourage safe, engaging, stimulating and active play to help promote development.

All staff are police checked for their suitability to work with children.

All staff are trained in first aid. In the unlikely event of any complaints please contact a member of staff or the headteacher.
