

## Homework – Autumn Term 2016

### Year 1 and 2

Reading books need to be in school every day and please remember to sign your child's Reading Record. Homework will be sent home on Fridays and should be returned to school by the following Tuesday. Children will receive spellings on a Friday that they need to practise for the following Friday.

### Year 3

Tuesday: Spelling homework due in following Monday

Friday: Times Tables (test on Fridays)

Reading - at least three times a week.

Friday: English or Maths task, due in following Friday.

After half-term - open ended tasks.

### Year 4 and 5.

Spellings and times tables each week. Children will also be expected to read at home daily, this will be recorded each day.

#### Homework could be:

**Maths** – linked to the current topic, learning times tables, number bonds, money, telling the time etc. and could be set as an activity (game/investigation) or a work sheet to consolidate their learning.

**English** – linked to the current topic, book reviews, and activities to consolidate the weeks learning. Reading and writing are also included when children research and report in their learning logs.

**Learning Logs** – these will be linked to our topics and/or an investigation/research. The learning logs are a great opportunity for the children to learn and be as creative in their learning as they choose. A topic/name/title etc will be put in the middle of 2 pages of the learning logs and the children can fill the double pages as creatively as they choose in relation to the subject. This could include: cartoon strip style pictures, photographs, magazine cuttings, images, texts – hand written and printed, colour, felt tip pens, collage, sticking... to make it interesting for the child and the reader.

Homework will usually be set on a **Friday** and must be handed in the following **Wednesday**. Children can hand it in earlier if they choose but it may not be looked at before Wednesday.

### Year 6

Reading – children in Year 6 are still expected to read at home every day.

Homework will be sent home on Fridays. This will consist of one piece of literacy, one piece of maths and spellings. **Homework could be:**

**Maths** – linked to the current topic, learning times tables, number bonds, money, telling the time etc. and could be set as an activity (game/investigation) or a work sheet to consolidate their learning.

**English** – linked to the current topic, book reviews, and activities to consolidate the weeks learning. Reading and writing are also included when children research and report in their learning logs.

**Learning Logs** – these will be linked to our topics and/or an investigation/research. The learning logs are a great opportunity for the children to learn and be as creative in their learning as they choose. A topic/name/title etc will be put in the middle of 2 pages of the learning logs and the children can fill the double pages as creatively as they choose in relation to the subject. This could include: cartoon strip style pictures, photographs, magazine cuttings, images, texts – hand written and printed, colour, felt tip pens, collage, sticking... to make it interesting for the child and the reader.
